

Oopsie! Note from Roxie: In the first edition of the cookbook somehow the first four ingredients of the first edition cookbook on Page 71 for Date-Filled Pinwheel cookies was inadvertently printed with some of the ingredients from Judy's delicious Butterfinger Cake on page 66, and the one-half cup butter was missing. Ingredients for these cookies are:

DATE-FILLED PINWHEEL COOKIES

1/2 cup butter

1 cup brown sugar, packed

1 egg

1/4 teaspoon salt

2 cups sifted all-purpose flour

4 teaspoon cinnamon

1/2 teaspoon soda

Cream butter; add sugar gradually; beat in egg. Blend in sifted dry ingredients; chill.



Make Date Filling.

DATE FILLING

3/4 cup chopped dates

1/3 cup water

1/3 cup sugar

1/3 cup finely chopped nuts

Cook dates in water until soft; add sugar; cook until thickened; stir; add nuts; cool. Divide dough into thirds; roll each piece on floured canvas into a rectangle 7 x 11 inches; spread with 1/3 of filling. Roll as for jelly roll starting at narrow edge; wrap in waxed paper; chill. Cut into thin slices; place on greased cookie sheets. Bake at 350 degrees about 12 minutes. Makes 9 dozen.

BREAKFAST CASSEROLE

6 slices white bread, crusts removed 5 eggs, beaten well (use mixer) ½ stick margarine 2 cups half & half cream 1½ cups shredded Longhorn cheese 1 pound sausage 1 t salt 1 t dry mustard

Cook sausage well and drain. Melt butter in 9X13 in. Pyrex pan. Tear bread in small pieces and sprinkle over butter. Sprinkle drained sausage over breadcrumbs. Sprinkle cheese over sausage. Beat eggs and other ingredients. Pour over mixture. Chill for 8 hours or overnight. Bake at 350 degrees for 40-50 minutes.

This is perfect for a lazy Saturday morning or to take to a Brunch.


