In Memory—Sara Brooks (Collins) Marr

LTM19 (MS Auxiliary), 119 (EANGUS Auxiliary)

Mrs. Sara Brooks (Collins) Marr, at age 92, departed this life for her heavenly reward from her residence in Tupelo on Friday morning, December 17, 2021. Brooks was a longtime educator, community leader, and faithful and engaged member of Harrisburg Baptist Church. She was the widow of the late William "Bill" Marr, Sr., U.S. Army, Ret., who died in 2013.

A service celebrating her life was held at 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, December 22, 2021 from the Sadie Holland Memorial Chapel of Holland Funeral Directors with Bro. David Smith officiating. A private family burial followed in Lee Memorial Park.

Brooks served as the MS NG NCO Association Auxiliary President 1988-1990 and as the EANGUS Auxiliary President 1994-1998. Brooks was also active in Family Readiness and the Mississippi State Advisory Team. Along with Auxiliary members Paula Carrigan and Vivian Taylor she was instrumental in beginning the Mississippi National Guard Youth Camp, Kids AT, and served as its first Camp Director. She continued to serve until health curtailed her activities.

Brooks leaves a legacy of service. Please remember her family in prayer.



Bost Urges DoD to Clarify Shifting Policy Impacting GI Bill Eligibility

Rep. Mike Bost (R-IL.), the Ranking Member of the House Committee on Veterans' Affairs, released the following statement after sending a letter to Secretary of Defense, Lloyd J. Austin III, regarding National Guard Members' eligibility for GI Bill benefits following the Biden Administration's recent termination of the national emergency declaration at the southern border.

"The Biden Administration's decision to reverse the emergency declaration at the southern border risks national security. It also risks the education of thousands of members of the National Guard who are still deployed there," said Ranking Member Bost. "Secretary Austin must immediately tell us whether those serving at the border since January 20th are receiving the same credit toward the GI Bill that they were on January 19th. Their service has not changed. Their benefits should not change either. The National Guard has stepped up in extraordinary ways over the last year. They have left their families and lives behind to serve on federal duty at the border, in DC, and elsewhere. Every single one of them should receive full GI Bill credit for their service. I stand ready to work with the Secretary to make sure they get exactly that."

The status of servicemembers of the National Guard currently serving at the southern border includes end strength and the statutory authority for their service. Rep. Bost asked for clarification on whether the rescission of Presidential Proclamation 9844 eliminates the ability for members of the National Guard currently serving on the southern border to continue to receive credit towards Post-9/11 GI Bill benefits and, if so, how that is being communicated to them.

As EANGUS members know, we are continually pushing for our well-deserved benefits. We will continue to monitor this situation and ensure everyone is receiving updated information. We will be assisting Rep. Bost with any follow on legislation he feels is needed.

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



OF MISSIS Chuck Bednarik played linebacker and center for the Philadelphia Eagles, the last true two-way player

Bednarik enlisted in the Army when he was 18 years old. He was a gunner on 30 missions in World War II and earned the Air Medal, four Oak Leaf Clusters, the European Theater

Operations Medal, four Battle Stars and the Good Conduct Medal. After his return to the United States in 1945 he enrolled at the University of Pennsylvania and joined the football team. He was the first offensive lineman in 1948 to win the Maxwell Award as college football's most outstanding player. He was selected by the Eagles with the first overall pick in the 1949 NFL draft. Bednarik was a stand-out on both sides of the ball, earning All-Pro honors at both center and linebacker over the course of his career; he became most famous for his hard-hitting plays on defense. He was the last player in NFL history to regularly participate in every play of an NFL game. He won two NFL championships (1949, 1960) with the Eagles. He retired after the 1962 season. Bednarik was named to eight career Pro Bowls and was inducted into the Pro Football Hall of Fame in 1967. Eagles' legend Chuck "Concrete Charlie" Bednarik was one of the best players to ever play in the city of Philadelphia

Different Classes of Membership for the Auxiliary

<u>EANGUS</u> <u>Auxiliary</u> <u>Associate Lifetime</u> Member—The rules are the same as for the Mississippi Auxiliary Associate Lifetime Member, except it is for the National Organization only and there will be no more dues. Cost is \$100.00.



State Auxiliary Presidents, Scholarship Chairperson, National Officers and Directors

Reference: Scholarship Rules

The Scholarship Committee of EANGUS Auxiliary is accepting applications for the school year 2022-2023. If funds are available, one USAA scholarship in the amount of \$3,000.00 will be awarded to the number one ranked applicant; one EANGUS Auxiliary Scholarship in the amount of \$2,000.00 will be awarded to the number two ranked applicant; one EANGUS Auxiliary Scholarship in the amount of \$1,500.00 will be awarded to the third ranked applicant; the fourth a n d fifth ranked applicants will receive \$1,000.00 each.

1. Please read materials carefully before giving any applications to candidates. Be prepared to give assistance if needed. No previous recipients are allowed to apply again.

2. In order for each application to be considered, it MUST contain the following documentation – NO EXCEPTIONS.

- a. Official High School/College Transcripts.
- b. Signed and dated letter from Applicant containing future goals and need for assistance. The letter must not be less than three hundred fifty (350) words and not to exceed five hundred (500) words.
- c. A Letter of Recommendation and Transmittal from the State Auxiliary President, Scholarship Chairperson or Designee indicating that the application is in order and has all documentation.
- 3. EANGUS Auxiliary sponsor must have dues paid to National Auxiliary no later than December 31, 2021.
- 4. For applicants to be eligible, sponsor's State Auxiliary must make a donation to the EANGUS Auxiliary Scholarship Fund for the current and prior year. (Mandatory donation is \$2.00 per member annually payable by December 31.)

It will be the responsibility of each State to make the information available to their membership. You may copy the application, however, DO NOT reduce it. Each State is to designate a Scholarship Chairperson and the applications returned to that person by a specific date. The application should then be reviewed to ensure all requirements have been met. Any incorrect applications received by the National Committee will be considered ineligible.

Each scholarship application to be considered by the National Committee must be mailed to Liz Bryant, 1 C Camino de Pinones, Glorieta, NM 87535. If there are any questions, I can be reached at labrab0704@gmail.com. Packets must be postmarked no later than June 30, 2022 to be considered.

The Enlisted Association of the National Guard of the United States Auxiliary Scholarship Awards Program is as follows:

The following persons are eligible:

- 1. EANGUS Auxiliary Members
- 2. Unmarried, children/step children, grandchildren/step grandchildren, up to age 26, of Annual and Life EANGUS Auxiliary Members.
- 3. Spouses of EANGUS Auxiliary Members OF MISSISSIP

Verification of membership in the EANGUS Auxiliary of the mother, father, step mother/father, grandparents/step grandparents, spouse or self is necessary for applicants to be eligible.

For applicants to be eligible, sponsor's State Auxiliary must have made a donation to the EANGUS Auxiliary Scholarship fund for the current year and the prior year. (Mandatory amount is \$2.00 per member per year payable by 31 December.)

Applicants must be enrolled at a university, college, business or trade school taking a minimum of eight accredited hours. <u>**Graduate students are not eligible**</u>.

An alternate recipient will be selected in case a recipient is unable to accept the award.

There shall be no consideration whatsoever given by the judges because of rank or grade of applicant, applicant's parents/step parents, grandparents/step grandparents or applicant's spouse.

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of scholastic achievement, character, leadership and need. All

applications must be accompanied by the following documentation:

- 1. An official transcript of high school credits and/or college credits for applicants already enrolled in institutions of higher learning.
- 2. Signed and dated letter from applicant with specific goals to continue his/her education and why financial aid is required, not less than three hundred fifty (350) words and not to exceed five hundred (500) words.
- 3. A letter of recommendation and transmittal from State Auxiliary President, Scholarship Chairperson or Designee.

Checks will be sent directly to the recipient, made payable to the institution of the recipient's choice, when verification of current enrollment is received by the committee chairperson.

These are one-time awards and shall not be repeated. Non-recipients may reapply so long as stated requirements are met. If the school term is not completed, due to cause other than sickness or injury, the student will refund the scholarship award in full to the EANGUS Auxiliary.

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of funds availability for the current year and the number of applicants.

1. On May 6, 1941, at an Army Air Corps Base (March Field in Riverside, California), Bob Hope performed and broadcast his first USO show for service members.

4. He has a lot of medals including the Congressional Gold Medal, Presidential Medal of Freedom, the Air Force Order of the Sword, Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Admiralty in the Great Navy of the State of Nebraska, and many more.
5. He was an honorary member of the Harlem Globetrotters.

Bob Hope, legendary comedian and star of radio, stage, and screen — not to mention a man who once played third billing to Siamese twins and trained seals — had a really, really soft spot for U.S. troops, especially those who deployed to combat zones. It's an amazing thing, especially considering that he was British.

For more than 50 years, the "One-Man Morale Machine" spent time away from his family and his comfortable Hollywood life to visit American troops during peacetime and at war. He performed on Navy ships and Army bases, often close enough to hear the sounds of combat. To him, that didn't matter. He one said, "Imagine those guys thanking me. Look what they're doing for me. And for you."

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
